- We are a 501 C (3) faith-based organization feeding the homeless, low-income families, veterans, single parents, and home health care shut ins. Our Goal is to improve the health of our community by lowering their medical issues.
- We keep accurate records of daily volunteer hours. We averaged 1058 volunteer hours per month in 2024.
- We distribute emergency food to individuals on an as needed basis.
- We have a number of homeless individuals who come in on Saturdays to get a box of approximately 35 lbs. of food.
- We provide food assistance through the process of open food banks distribution to the public on Fridays from 8-11:00 am and Saturdays from 8-12 noon.
- We allow our homeless individuals and their family to volunteer.
- We help homeless individuals with rain gear protection and tents per known needs.
- We utilize volunteers that are in recovery programs (ACE – without permanent housing) and offered community service opportunities.
- We have served 7104 families since 2012.
- We distribute an average of 74,000 pounds of food each month.
- We also provide pet food and supplies.
